#### **GAFUTURES FUNDING APPLICATION**

To receive funding for dual enrollment courses, students must complete the Georgia Futures funding application at <a href="https://www.gafutures.org">www.gafutures.org</a>.

Both the <u>student</u> and the <u>parent/legal guardian</u> must complete the participation agreement in order for the student to participate in the dual enrollment program.



\*UWG WILL NOT REGISTER STUDENTS WHO HAVE NOT COMPLETED BOTH REQUIREMENTS WITHIN THE FUNDING APPLICATION.

# DUAL ENROLLMENT FUNDING

- Maximum funding is 30 credit hours per student
- Students can take up to 15 credit hours per semester
- Students are only able to withdraw from a course twice before they can no longer participate in Dual Enrollment
- Funding will not pay for a student to repeat a course
