# GAFUTURES FUNDING APPLICATION

To receive funding for dual enrollment courses, students must complete the Georgia Futures funding application at [www.gafutures.org](http://www.gafutures.org).

Both the student and the parent/legal guardian must complete the participation agreement in order for the student to participate in the dual enrollment program.

# DUAL ENROLLMENT FUNDING

- Maximum funding is 30 credit hours per student
- Students can take up to 15 credit hours per semester
- Students are only able to withdraw from a course twice before they can no longer participate in Dual Enrollment
- Funding will not pay for a student to repeat a course
